

WHAT: Broadway Bridge Rehabilitation Project

WHEN: The Week of May 12, 2025

The City of Saskatoon (City) along with **Julmac Contracting Ltd.**, will begin the proactive maintenance on Broadway Bridge the week of May 12, 2025. This work will take approximately **6 months** to complete barring weather delays and unforeseen circumstances and will include:

- Concrete deck repairs,
- Waterproofing replacement
- New asphalt
- New traffic barriers
- Repairs and improvements to the multi-use pathways
- Repairs to the arches and piers
- Expansion joint replacements
- Removal of abandoned utilities underneath the bridge
- Improvements to existing utility infrastructure
- Intersection Improvements

Important Project Information

Also included in this project is the reconfiguring of the 4th Avenue South and 19th Street East intersection into a standard “T”. Modifications will include relocating traffic signals, adding pedestrian signals and removing the traffic island and centre medians. The right flow through lane onto 4th Avenue South northbound will also be removed.

Water main and sewer replacement on 4th Avenue and 19th Street will occur concurrently with this work to maximise the usage of the closure.

What to Expect During Construction

The closure is expected to be in place May 12, 2025. Once implemented, the bridge and intersection will be fully closed to both vehicles and pedestrians. Meewasin Trail on both sides of the river will remain open during construction with scaffolding tunnels, similar to previous bridge rehabilitations. The public boat launch will also remain open for the duration of construction.

The contractor is planning 24/7 work. Typically, the work at night is debris clean-up and other tasks that are low noise levels.
